Welcome to the 2026 season at Maitland Junior Football Club.

The adherence by all to the codes of conduct should ensure an enjoyable season for everyone involved.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT AND TEAM RULES

Attend each training session and each game. If you are not going to be at training or the game you must notify your manager.

You are expected to be at each game even if under suspension.

The player is required to be at the ground at the time allocated by the coach.

A player registered with Maitland Junior Football Club and in Club uniform or representing the Club will at all times be courteous and polite and must not engage in any public acts of misconduct or unruly behaviour.

A player registered with Maitland Junior Football Club must accept all reasonable directions given by the Team or Club Management.

Do not argue with the Referee or Assistant Referees or abuse or address them in insulting terms or act in a provocative manner both on and off the field.

A player must not use crude or abusive language or engage in any conduct detrimental to the spirit or image of the game. At all times play by the rules of the game.

Being sent from the field of play will not only result in disciplinary action by the Joint Judiciary but may also result in disciplinary action by your Coach or the Committee of the Club.

No sledging or bagging of your team mates or other Maitland teams.

Remember to treat other people as you would like to be treated.

Work hard for yourself and your team and enjoy your football.

Listen to the directions and instructions from your coach NOT the advice and comments from the sidelines.

If any player is found to have breached the Code of Conduct and Team Rules, the Club Committee may disqualify, suspend or otherwise deal with the player concerned.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

No Coaching from the side line. The Coach will deal with game strategies, positions and performance. Players of parents coaching will be placed on the bench during the match and may start the next match from the bench.

Notify the Manager if your child will not be at training or the match. If the Manager is not notified or the reason is frivolous your child will start the next match from the bench.

No negative or abusive comments to the team or opposition when team is playing.

Encourage your child to play as a team member.

Your child is required to attend all training sessions and all matches. If they are not able to be at training or the match, the Manager must be notified.

Canteen duties and laundering the playing shirts are responsibilities for each team and parents are required to attend these duties when asked by your Team Manager.

Coaches are not to be approached by parents, all parent enquiries are to be to the Manager. If the Manager does not resolve the enquiry the Secretary is to be notified.

COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT AND TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

Ensure a fair and disciplined atmosphere at training and games.

Continue the development of players.

Attend all training sessions and matches. Notify the Secretary/Registration if you are unable to attend training or the match. Ensure that players over the season have equal time on the field.

Verbal or physical abuse of players is not permitted.

Make sure all players are collected by parents after training and matches.

In conjunction with the Manager, complete team sheet at least 15 minutes before kickoff time.

Any disciplinary action that would not allow a player to take the field for a minimum of a half a match is to be discussed with the Secretary/Registrar or Coaching Co Ordinator before any such action is implemented.

Ensure Team Management and Players conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times.

Consult with the Secretary/Registrar on any player/parent problems.

Be responsible for equipment issued. Notify the Gear Steward when equipment requires replacement.

MANAGERS CODE OF CONDUCT AND TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

Provide administrative assistance to the Team's Coach. Managers are not assistant coaches.

Complete team sheet on Squadi at least 15 minutes before kickoff time.

Organise Canteen, shirt laundering and ground setup or pack up rosters for parents. (information will come from the Secretary/Registrar. Notify parents of photograph date and time.

Maintain a training and playing record in conjunction with the coach.

No verbal or physical abuse of players is permitted.

Notify parents if any fees are outstanding when contacted by the Treasurer.

Discuss with Coach any problems/concerns that may be raised with you from parents/players.

Ensure team knows fixtures addresses.

Make sure all players are collected by parents after training and matches.

Be responsible for equipment issued. Notify the Gear Steward when equipment requires replacement.

Ensure all team shirts are washed and returned to the club at the end of the season, failure to return all shirts will result in a fine to the team: MiniRoos \$22 per shirt. Competition \$35 per shirt.

Bring to the attention of the Coach and/or Secretary any concerns.

MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

All members of Maitland Junior FC will adhere to our Codes of Conduct.

Any abuse of any volunteer by a member will result in disciplinary action for them by the Executive Committee of Maitland Junior FC.
